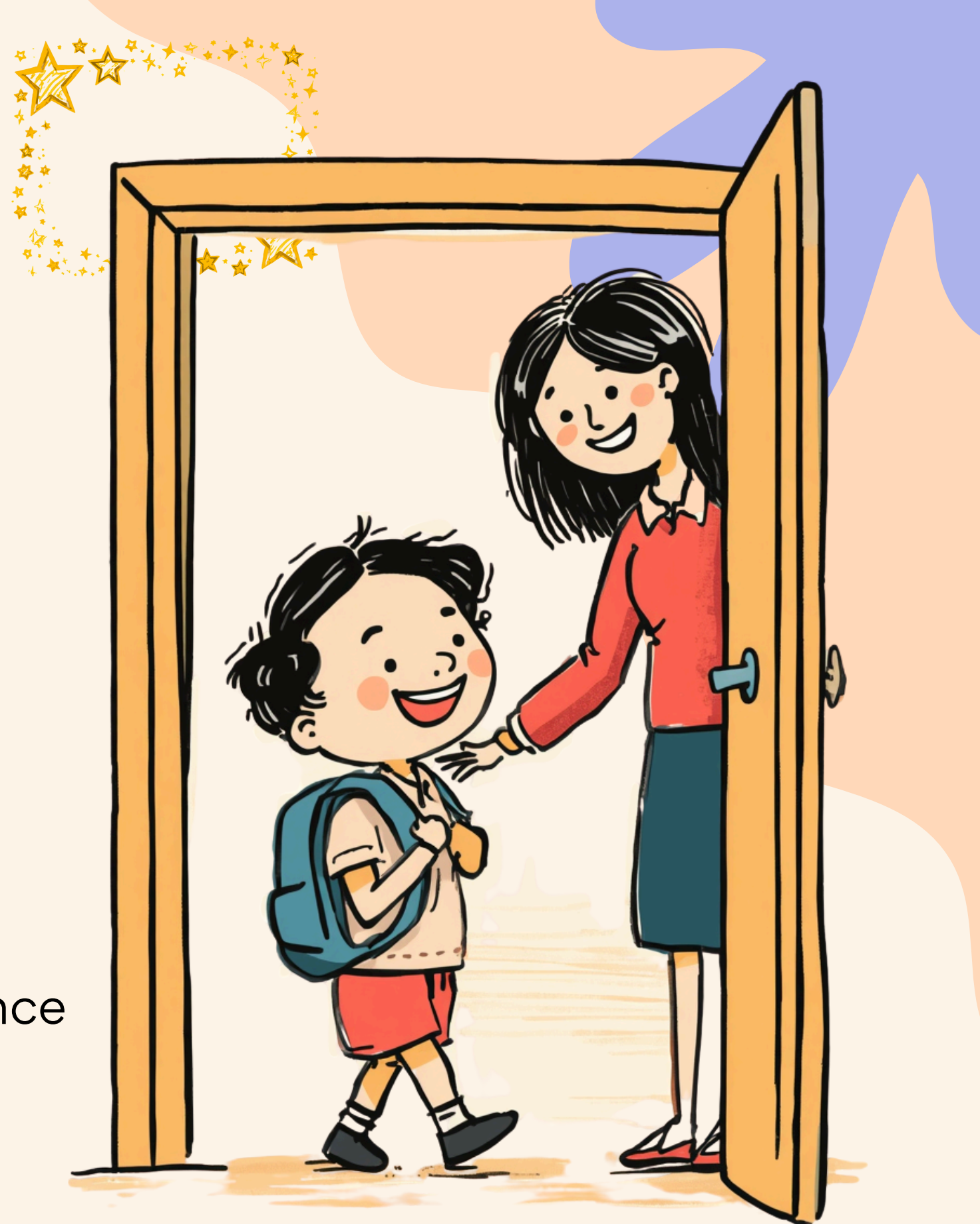

The government say that a holiday is not considered an exceptional circumstance. You cannot usually take your child away during term time.

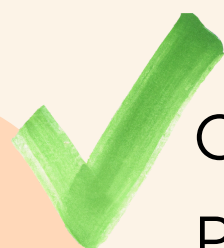

Did you know?

- Better attendance means better success.
- Just 10 days off reduces SATs performance by 25%.
- Persistently absent pupils with less than 90% attendance earn £10,000 less by age 28.
- 95% isn't good attendance—it means 10 days off - that's 2 whole weeks of missed school!
